On December 19, 2018, the individuals listed below representing the mmWave Coalition (“mmWC” or the “Coalition”) met with Commission staff to discuss proposed rule changes to facilitate development of new technologies and services in spectrum bands above 95 GHz. In the meeting, the mmWC representatives asked the Commission to authorize bandwidths larger than what is contemplated in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, suggesting additional bands not covered by footnote US246 as well as the potential for sharing with passive services in bands above 95 GHz that are covered by that footnote. The Coalition’s previous submissions in this proceeding,¹ as well as the attached presentation served as the basis for our discussion.
